That might sound like a tough challenge but there is a new structure for membership. The idea is similar to how a community currently registers in the evaluated program based on their population size. Small community, smaller fee.


Creating a strong communication network with past, present and future Communities in Bloom supporters is the number one goal. Membership will help to:
